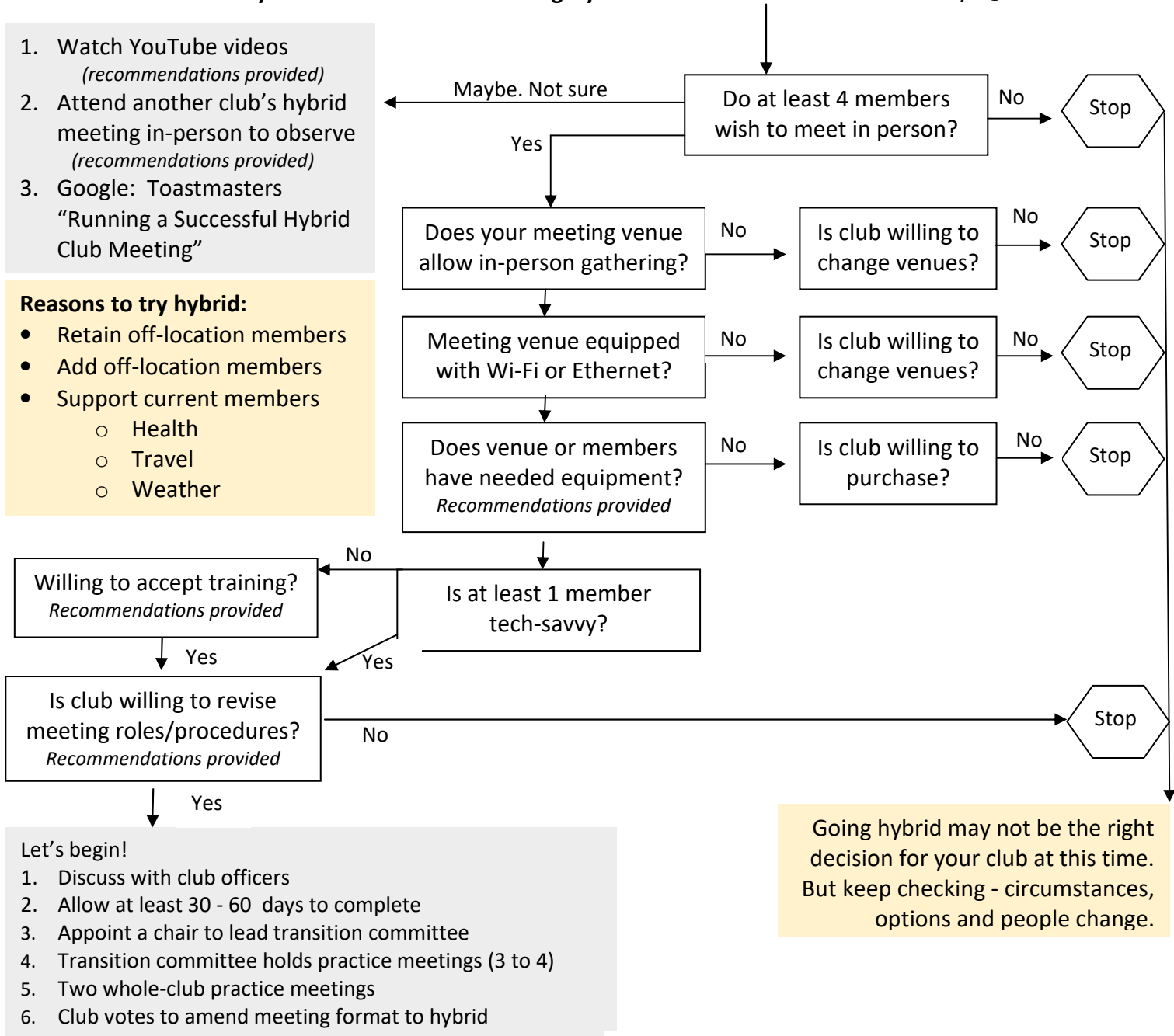

Reasons to try hybrid:

- Retain off-location members
- Add off-location members
- Support current members
 - Health
 - Travel
 - Weather



Going hybrid may not be the right decision for your club at this time. But keep checking - circumstances, options and people change.

Minimum equipment for 6 or fewer in-person attendees:

- Wi-Fi or Ethernet connectivity
- One device at lectern so that online participants can see/hear in-person speaker
- One laptop so that in-person audience can see and hear online participants.
- Optional: external speaker
- Possible: cables and adapters for needed connections

Minimum equipment for up to 20 in-person attendees:

- Large monitor or projector to display Zoom Gallery so in-person audience can see online participants
- External speaker so in-person audience can hear online participants.
- Laptop, logged into Zoom, control monitor/projector and external speaker
- One device at lectern so that online participants can see/hear in-person speaker
- Optional: Chatmaster and device
- Optional: Ethernet junction box, allows multiple devices to access Ethernet
- Possible: cables and adapters for needed connections
