# **Our Meeting Roles**

You may be interested in how our meeting roles differ from what you're used to:

- **TipMaster** (Toastmaster/Pathways/Midway/Technology Tip): An experienced member educates us for one to two minutes on a related subject..
- Word /Joke/Thought of the Day: Each supports the meeting theme.
- **TopicsMaster:** Selects questions supporting the meeting theme. We usually have for three impromptu speakers who may answer using the HARDR options.
- **Speakers:** Typically there are two or three speakers depending on the length. Speeches are prepared based on the objectives of the speaker's project.
- **General Evaluator:** Provides constructive feedback on the meeting and our use of technology. He/she oversees the evaluation team:
  - Evaluator: An evaluator is usually assigned to each speaker; however speakers may request a round-robin evaluation for even more feedback.
  - Timer
  - Ah-Counter
  - Grammarian
- Toastmaster of the Day: In addition toserving as the master of ceremonies of the meeting, the Toastmaster of the Day also presents award ribbons to the best topics speaker, best prepared-speech speaker and best evaluator. Recipients follow the "TCUT" formula in making their acceptance comments.
- **Presiding Officer:**The club president (usually)makes announcements, invites comments and adjourns the meeting.
